Dear Mr. Higgins;
We wish to object to the expansion of BORTADROHA LANDFILL SITE, Co. LIMERICK on the following grounds:-
We do not wish to live around here for another 20 years under stress from Limerick Co. Council due to pollution of the atmosphere - with Methane gas, odours, inadequate BIRD control measures, ground water pollution & do not wish to see the area depopulated any further because people are

forced out of their land & homes by Limerick Co. Council. We have already lost 4 families + three further houses are locked up.

The cause of the major fish kill of May 2004 has never been explained. For a 3 mile stretch down river from the dump all fish were dead & immediately upstream above the pipe coming in from ^{dump} all fish were alive. It all points to Limerick Co. Council's fault, but they weren't brought to justice. This is the 3rd time in 8 years they have killed the fish in the White River. After all the people have been through

around here for the past 14 yrs. They have lost all faith & trust in Limerick Co. Council

The possibility of gravel aquifers in the proposed extension site has not been fully researched. This important issue has to be clarified.

Limerick Co. Council should be forced to reduce their waste in line with European Standards for waste management. The need for expansion of this facility has not been established with adequate space available in Co. Clare & Co. Kerry,
