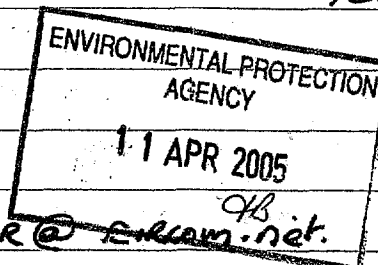

Dear Sir/Madam,

If a license application has been made,
or is about to be made, for extra pig
breeding/rearing capacity at either the pig
farm or sow breeding station, at the
above locations, please note that we wish
to object on the following grounds:

1. Additional offensive odours will be caused.
2. Noise levels will increase, especially at feeding.
3. Extra heavy traffic will be generated, on
already poor and narrow roads.
4. There will be extra pollution caused to
the River Slaney, - even now effluent can be
seen flowing in near Killurin Quay.
5. There will be the problem of disposal of
extra slurry, at present spreading causes
offence.
6. Local people fear this is a step
toward an 'Anaerobic digester' being sited
at Kilpatrick.
