I am not against the proposal in principle to erect an incinerator but I am fearful of the emissions that will emanate from the operation of the incinerator if not properly managed. I have had experience of living beside the Cement factory outside Duleek for many years and I am of the opinion that my children developed asthma as a result of emissions from that factory.

I understand that the Environmental Protection Agency will be charged with monitoring the operation of the incinerator. I wish to put on record that I have no real confidence in that agency and wish to know what safeguards you propose to put in place to ensure that myself and my family's health are not compromised as a result of the operation of this incinerator.
