
I refer to an application for a Waste Licence submitted by Indaver Ireland to the Agency on the 5th December 2001.

I have been requested by the Elected Members of Drogheda Borough Council to make a submission on their behalf objecting to the granting of a Licence for this facility.

The principal matters expressed by the Members of this Local Authority at their meeting on the 4th March, 2002 related to the health effects on the residents adjacent to the site and surrounding areas and also the atmospheric pollution that the facility will cause. Significant concerns were also expressed about the close proximity of the Incinerator to the town of Drogheda.
