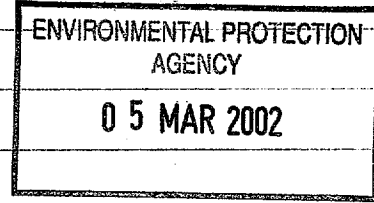
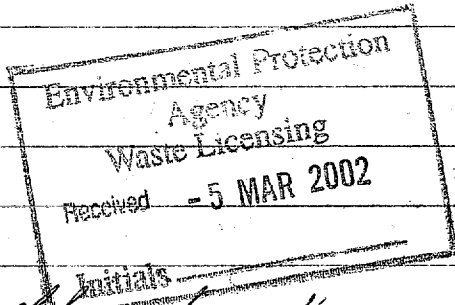

Dear Sir,

I would like to appeal as an
observer of the No Incinerator Alliance Co.
against the Meath Co. Council granting
Planning Permission to Indaver Ireland
for Waste Management Facility and
Incinerator at Carnamstown, Duleek,
Co Meath (Planning application No 01/4014.)

- (1) Being next door to such a development will greatly increase the noise level for the proposed six days a week 24 hour operation (six lorries per hour around the clock)
- (2) The smoke and noxious fumes from the chimneys will adversely affect my health and that of any person or animal living in my home or on my land.

3. Having being accustomed to normal rural living I will find myself completely surrounded on all sides by industrial activity, which would have a dramatic and utterly negative impact on my daily life.
4. There would doubtless be litter and waste materials that would find their way onto my land.

Furthermore in view of the scale of this project and very large number of signed petitions against this development I further demand a public enquiry into the 'environmental' impacts and the resultant health effects that this incinerator will cause.
