I would like to appeal as an observer of the No Incinerator Alliance Co, against the Meath County Council granting Planning Permission to Indaver Ireland for Waste Management Facility and Incinerator at Baulstown Co Meath (Planning Application No 01/4014)

The reasons I strenuously object are,
1 My family have lived here for the last 40 years, and there are 3 generations living here at the moment ages from 68 yrs to 4 years, and we have been living beside Irish Cement Factory for the last 30 yrs which has been a terrible nuisance and noise to us day and night and traffic and dust.
2 An Incinerator now proposed, will add greatly to our problems, regarding the
