Location of Development: Carranstown, Duleek, Co. Meath.

With reference to the above, I wish to object to the application made by Indaver for a waste license for the following reasons:

An Incinerator will Damage food and water in the area for generations to come.

Indaver has admitted that there is to be up to 30,000 TONNES of Highly TOXIC WASTE per year after the Barring of Waste which we now find out that it is to be Dumped Locally, creating a Serious health problem in the Future.
