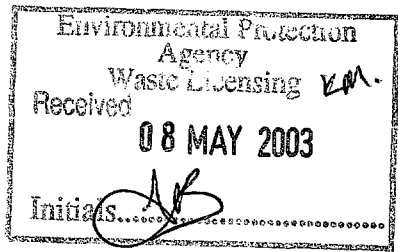

With reference to the above, I wish to object to the application made by Indaver for a waste license for the following reasons:

There are not many areas in Ireland which can lay claim to such a wide ranging and rich heritage as the Boyne Valley and surrounding area. From Newgrange (oldest man-made structure in the world) to the historic Battle of the Boyne, from Mellifont Abbey (treaty signed deciding the course of Irish history) to Drogheda town itself, steeped in history with some of the old gates and walls remaining intact, reminders of a by-gone era. An incinerator in this area would destroy the old world heritage and directly affect the tourism industry.
