With reference to the above, I wish to object to the application made by Indaver for a waste license for the following reasons:

- No Waste Segregation PRIOR to incineration
- Delay on analyse dioxin emissions
- Emission limits
- Will dioxins be monitored?
- Who do EPA: Use to carry out dioxin sampling at Plant?
- Does EPA have the ability to analyse samples to measure dioxin emissions
- What MEASURES ARE taken to protect local Aquifer Reserve
- How will the Public be informed of test results
- What guarantees do we have that Carranstown plant will not have the same problems as Belgium?
