With reference to the above planning proposal, I wish to make an appeal on the application made by Indaver for an IPC License for the following reasons:

To issue a licence to Indaver Ireland for the Duleek Area would be catastrophic to our children and our children's children. Nobody believes that incinerators can be run safely and efficiently measured for dioxin emissions. You might as well give us all a deadly dose of poison because the results would be the same. I am amazed that Indaver got planning permission for an incinerator in such close proximity to a major town like Drogheda. I would appreciate a written acknowledgement of this letter and confirmation that my objection is a valid one.

E.P.A. Please do not ignore the dangers caused to all of us from incineration. The proposed incinerator is based on one similar in Europe, which had to be closed down due to dioxin levels being over 300 times higher than EU permitted levels. Ireland does not have the ability to measure such emissions. Could we ever trust a money making facility like "Indaver" to run it safely, I strongly doubt it.
