Re: INDAVER IRELAND WASTE APPLICATION Reg No. 167-1

Location of Development: Carranstown, Duleek, Co. Meath.

With reference to the above, I wish to object to the application made by Indaver for a waste license for the following reasons:

Firstly, the site for the incinerator has been blasted by the senior planning inspectors who heard all the evidence against it at the oral hearing (those who overruled his decisions did not) and who has stated permission should be refused. We already have an environmental unfriendly cement plant beside the proposed incinerator. It is in the centre of a farming area with 3 large dairy herds in the immediate vicinity and also a primary school a short distance away. The Environmental Protection Agency site selection process was not used by the developers and the site was solely selected by Indaver Managing Director John O'Brien without consultation with the Council. It is in the area of a novel farmers Heritage site. These are some of the reasons I strongly object to the proposed incinerator.

I would appreciate a written acknowledgement of this letter, and confirmation that my objection is a valid one.
