Group we would like the following submission  
to be considered in the issuing of an

Co Meath on the following grounds.

My home is approx 150 meters from the  
proposed incinerator, and from Just Cement Works  
Platten, which is already a risk to my  
health. I am also subject to blasting at  
Cement Works Platten.

At the moment the traffic is very heavy  
and crossing the road is impossible  
and I dread to think what it will  
be like when the proposed Incinerator

goes ahead.

Being next door to the proposed development it is very unfair to me as my family lived here for over a hundred years.

The smoke and noxious fumes from the chimney will adversely affect my health and that of any person or animal living in my home or on my land.

Having being accustomed to normal rural living I will find myself completely surrounded on all sides by noxious activities which would have a dramatic and utterly negative impact on my daily life.
