DEAR SIR,

RE SUBMISSION REGARDING THE PROPOSED INDIAVER MUNICIPAL WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY AT CARRYSTOWN, DULEEK, COMEATH.

AS MEMBERS OF THE CARRYSTOWN RESIDENTS GROUP, WE WOULD LIKE THE FOLLOWING SUBMISSION TO BE CONSIDERED IN THE ISSUING OF AN INTEGRATED POLLUTION CONTROL IPC LICENSE TO THE PROPOSED INDIAVER MUNICIPAL WASTE FACILITY AT CARRYSTOWN, DULEEK, COMEATH ON THE FOLLOWING GROUNDS.

WE HAVE 3 YOUNG CHILDREN ATTENDING MOUNT HANOVER SCHOOL, AND THEY ARE ALREADY BEING EXPOSED TO THE DUST AND TOXINS FROM IRISH CEMENT PLATIN. WE LIVE ABOUT 200 METERS FROM IRISH CEMENT, AND THE SAME FROM THE PROPOSED INCINERATOR. TWO OF MY CHILDREN ARE SUFFERING FROM ASTHMA, AND THEY WILL ALSO HAVE THE TOXINS AND EMISSIONS FROM THE PROPOSED PLANT AS WELL. THE TRAFFIC IS AN AWFUL PROBLEM AND WITH CHILDREN, THERE IS THE RISK OF ACCIDENTS, AS THERE HAS BEEN 3 FATALITIES ON THIS STRETCH OF ROAD.

OUR HOUSE WILL BE DEVALUED AND WE WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO BUY A NEW HOUSE, WITH THE VALUE OF HOUSES AT TODAY'S PRICES.

THERE IS A NATURAL GAS PIPELINE ALREADY ON THIS SITE, AND WITH THE GEMENT BLASTING IN THEIR QUARRY CLOSE TO THE SITE, IT WOULD BE EXTREMELY DANGEROUS OF EXPLOSIONS. WE STRONGLY OBJECT TO THIS PROPOSED PLANT.
