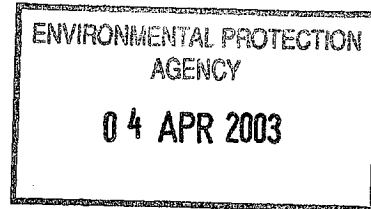

With reference to the above planning proposal, I wish to
make an appeal on the application made by Indaver for an
IPC License for the following reasons.

I am an concerned parent for Mount Harover N.S.
which is located less than one mile from the proposed
site for an incinerator. I have two children at the school.
I fear for their health and safety. My family
live about 2 1/2 miles from this proposed site. I feel
our livelihood would be in danger of disaster. We
run a Dairy Farm, hand down to third generation.
My husband and myself and children all help out to
keep the farm. We work seven days a week and
no holidays to look after our cows. I fear for the
future, if this incinerator comes to Carranstown.

I am all in favour to re-use, reduce and re-cycle.
I recycle all my rubbish as best I can.
There is no need to build an incinerator in Carranstown.
Is it really worth all the RISK involved?
