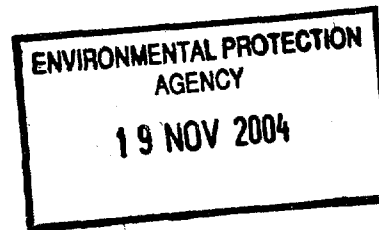
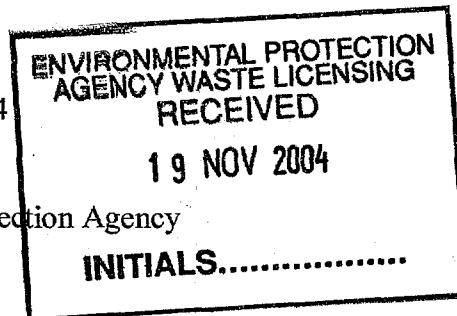

**Re: Objection to the Granting of Waste Licence under Application Reg No. 167-1 to Indaver Ireland for a Waste Management Facility including a Non-Hazardous Waste Incinerator at Carranstown, Duleek, Co. Meath.**

A Chara

The elected members of Louth County Council wish to lodge an objection to the granting of a licence for an incinerator at Carranstown, Dunleek Co. Meath. The members gave the following reasons for their objection:-

- Risk to health of the people of Drogheda and surrounding areas
- The lack of apparatus in Ireland which can monitor emissions from incinerators (according to the report from the Health Research Board)
- The policy of reduce, reuse and recycle should be given more time to progress before consideration is given to the introduction of incineration
- The need for quicker test results on dioxin levels before allowing an incinerator plant – at present it takes six weeks to obtain test results on dioxin levels from England.
