Matter of Objection: Undefined clarity in certain drea's on the proposed License

This letter is to lodge a formal objection to the proposed Waste management License for Indaver Ireland, Reference File 167-1 at Carranstown, Duleek, Co. Meath.

## Point 1:

From the introduction the EPA state that the Licensee must manage and operate the facility to ensure that the activities do not cause environmental pollution. We object on the grounds that, as this is the first ever waste management facility being constructed in Ireland, that an external body should be responsible for Monitoring the environmental pollution. Can the EPA ensure that a company, whose ultimate aim is to run a profitable business, will adhere to all guidelines and be accurate in their monitoring and reporting?

## Point 2:

As set out in conditions 1 scope 1.4, if the agreed tonnes per annum of 170,000 is reached early in the year, does this mean the facility must close for the remainder of the year? Our objection on this point is that in the licence terms, there has been no guidelines set out as to what measures would be taken if the agreed tonnage were reached. There is nothing in the License referring to how this tonnage will be monitored by an external body.

## Point 3:

What provisions have the Liscencee made to ensure they do not accept hazardous waste on Liquid wastes.

## Point 4:

Condition 2 Management of the facility 2.3.2.5 Corrective action, it is stated in "In the event of a reported non conformity with this License shall be define" We as local farmers who produce Milk, vegetables, beef, lamb and cereal crops would have a big concern with the statement "Shall be defined" We object on the grounds that within the Licence this provisions should be defined at the offset of the facility and not when functioning.
