RE: Waste Management Licence – Indaver Ireland Carranstown, Duleek, Co Meath

At the Council's District Development Committee Meeting held on Monday 15 November 2004 the following resolution was adopted:-

"That Newry & Mourne District Council formally lodge an objection against the granting of a Waste Management Licence by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to Indaver to operate an incinerator facility at Carranstown, Duleek, County Meath, which will have a serious and negative impact on the social, economical and environmental well being of many communities including those in our own administrative area."

In particular this Council would like to object to the terms of Waste Licence 167-1 on the following grounds: Insufficient monitoring is indicated or even designed to meet the requirements of condition 1.10(a). There are serious concerns regarding the frequency and extent of monitoring. In particular there are real fears that this could lead to trans boundary transport of toxic pollutants such as dioxins and furans.

This Council believes that an incineration plant would be detrimental to the well being of those communities who live in the vicinity of the plant or indeed those people living in areas that may be affected by the fallout. The appriopriate fee of €190.46 is enclosed.
