Dear Dr. Kelly / Members of EPA Board,

The No Incineration Alliance hereby formally invite you to attend the Oral Hearing into the granting of the EPA draft licence to Indaver Ireland for an incineration facility at Carranstown, Duleek, Drogheda, Co. Meath.

This hearing will be held in the Boyne Valley Hotel, Drogheda, Co.Louth from 11am on March 7th 2005.

In preparation for the forthcoming hearing, we also formally request a copy of the following documentation pertaining to the Indaver application for licence (under Council Directive 90/313/EEC on the freedom of access to information on the environment):

1. Indaver Environmental Impact Statement or EIS report
2. Indaver Plant Operating Procedures
3. Indaver Plant Emergency Action Plan
4. Indaver Environmental Impact Statement or EIS "Worst-impact Scenario" including but not limited to how many people would be harmed, where they lived, how long the harm lasts etc.
5. Indaver statement on how it will handle Asbestos and Radioactive waste
6. Indaver Logistics Accident Plan (Emergency plan for haulage of material on Public Roads)
7. Indaver or EPA Consultants Appraisals – e.g. air quality, water quality, climatic impacts etc.
8. Any other submitted and pertinent documentation from Indaver / their associates.
