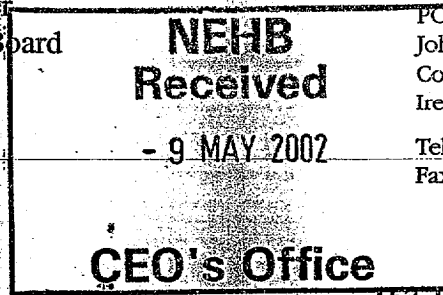

I am to inform you in accordance with Article 18(3) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, that additional information relevant to the EIS has been received by the Agency on 03/05/02. A copy of the additional information is enclosed for your information.

I am to advise you that any person may make a submission to the Agency, in writing, in respect of the application, pursuant to Article 15 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2000, which provides as follows:

Extract from the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2000 (S.I. 185 of 2000)

Submissions to the Agency regarding applications

15. For the purpose of section 40(2)(b) of the Act, a person may make a written submission to the Agency in relation to -
- (i) an application, and
 - (ii) such plans, documents and other information and particulars, including an environmental impact statement, as are submitted by the applicant in accordance with articles 12, 13, 14 and 16.
- and the Agency shall not give notice of a proposed decision under section 42(2) of the Act before the expiry of a period of one month following the date of a relevant -
- (a) acknowledgement in accordance with article 14(2)(a), or
 - (b) notice in accordance with article 16(2)(a), or
 - (c) acknowledgement in accordance with article 16(4),
- whichever such date is the later.

The Agency will have regard to any submission made in accordance with the Regulations and will write, in due course, to each person who makes such a submission, to advise them of the Agency's proposed decision on the application.
