***Waste Licence Application Ref: 167-1 Indaver Ireland  
Incinerator at Carranstown, Duleek, Co. Meath.***

Dear Ms. O'Sullivan,

I write to make a formal objection to the issuing of a waste licence for an incinerator at Carranstown, Co. Meath. The premise that the proposed facility is for non-hazardous waste is a false premise. Household, commercial and industrial waste de facto contains a wide variety of materials which, if combusted, will create an unquantifiable and toxic chemical cocktail. The facility is in reality proposing to burn hazardous waste at least in part and this is expressly outside the terms of the licence in question.

As Spokesperson on Agriculture & Food for the Green Party/Comhaontas Glas, I also object to the licence on the basis that it will damage the marketability and quality of agricultural produce over a wide radius.

Accordingly, I request an Oral Hearing to more fully explain the basis for this objection and enclose my cheque in the sum of €253.95.
