




PROPOSED DECISION

Waste Licence 123 – 1

**FOLLOWING ARE OBJECTIONS/AMENDMENTS TO THE
PROPOSED LICENCE FOR CUSTOM COMPOST LIMITED.**

3.5.5.

The integrity of all hard standing areas and drains shall be assessed by a suitably qualified independent engineer at least every two years and reported to the agency on each occasion or following the installation of any new drains/areas of hard standing and prior to their use.

3.7.1.

Within six months of the date of grant of this licence, the licensee shall provide a purpose enclosed building(s) or structure(s) for the dry storage of poultry litter, horse manure and gypsum. This structure(s) shall be constructed in a manner suitable, and be of size appropriate, for the storage of poultry litter, gypsum and horse manure and be inspected annually.

3.11.1

The licensee shall ensure that the following program of works shall be carried out to eliminate odours emissions from the facility. The program of works shall proceed based on the following.

- (i) Within three months of the date of grant of this licence, the licensee shall provide adequate aerated floor facilities for use in the Phase I and Phase 2 composting process to be followed by total enclosure of the system.

- (iv) Unless otherwise agreed by the Agency, within six months of the date of grant of this licence the licensee shall enclose all goodie water storage tanks and provide absolute odour filtration systems placed at outlet vents on all goodie/process water storage tanks.

3.11.2

Within twelve months of the date of grant of this licence, the licensee shall submit a report assessing the effectiveness of the odour control measures implemented at the facility, this will also be checked by an independent assessor who shall report on the findings on the control measures implemented at the facility. These control measures should monitor Nox Sox, Co Emissions along with water pollution testing.

4.4.2

An independent assessor shall submit a report to the Agency within three months of date of grant of this licence on limiting the use of security lighting at night, and assessing alternative systems as to avoid nuisance and visual intrusion. The findings of this report shall be implemented as agreed by the Agency.

4.6.1

All treatment/abatement and emission control equipment shall be calibrated and maintained, in accordance with the instructions issued by the manufacturer/supplier or installer. Written records of the calibrations and maintenance shall be made and kept by the independent assessor and a copy for E.P.A. The E.P.A and licensee shall maintain and clearly label and name all sampling and monitoring locations which will be situated so as to give a full 360 degree monitoring of the plant at all times.

4.8.2

- (ii) A substitution rate of at least 30% within six months of date of grant of this licence.

5.6.2

- (c) Complete enclosure of areas causing trigger levels to be broken.

7.1

E.P.A personnel and independent observers shall carry out such monitoring and at such locations and frequencies as set out in *Schedule E. Monitoring*, of this licence and as specified in this licence. Unless otherwise specified by this licence, all environmental monitoring shall commence immediately after the date of grant of this licence.

7.2

Delete this sub-section as no alteration of the parameters should be changed.

7.8.1

The licensee shall, during the morning on a daily basis, inspect the facility and its immediate surrounds for nuisances caused by litter, vermin, birds, flies, mud, dust and odours. Subjective daily odour assessments shall be carried out by site personnel either prior to, or immediately following their arrival on-site. Independent checks should also be carried out on a regular basis.

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SCHEDULE D: Night-time noise level to be changed to 35dB as per Council recommendations.
