

Appeal Re:

I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer to the above appeal.

In accordance with section 2(2)(a) of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1992, it is a statutory objective of the Board to ensure that every appeal received is determined within four months beginning on the date of receipt of that appeal. Where it appears to the Board that it would not be possible or appropriate to determine a particular appeal within this period, a notice must be sent to the parties in accordance with section 2(3)(a) of the Act.
