


**Re: Application for review of licence by Midland Waste Disposal Company Ltd.,
Proudstown, Navan, Co. Meath.**

In my opinion the EIS has not sufficiently described the nature and extent of the proposed extension of business. Please request applicant to submit the following further information:

1. Details of additional classes, quantities and methods of treatment of waste the applicant proposes to accept at the facility. Request applicant to clearly indicate on plan the yard areas which he proposes to extend.
2. Details of the location and design of the proposed composting unit. Request applicant to submit information regarding the type and quantity of waste which shall be treated in this unit. Applicant shall describe fully the composting process and emissions arising from the proposed unit. Applicant shall submit proposals for the treatment of any odours arising from this unit.
3. The results of the noise survey indicate that noise levels are currently above the limits outlined in the licence. Applicant shall submit proposals to address this issue. Please request applicant to submit details of analysis of noise emissions for tonal and impulsive components. The proposed expansion of operating hours would result in elevated noise levels above the limits set for night-time which may result in a noise nuisance. In my opinion no extension of operating hours should be granted.
4. Please request applicant to submit further information regarding levels of rodent activity at the site.
