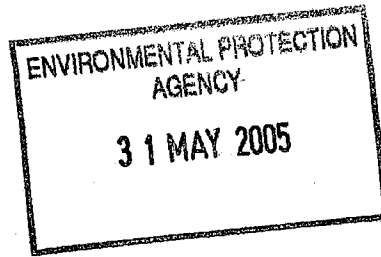

Dear sir / madam,

I wish to object to the proposed grant of

licence to the above for the following reasons;

- 1) The piggery is located close to the scenic view Slaney
~~and~~ much of which is designed as S.A.C. (NOT
candidate SAC as frequently + conveniently referred to)
- 2) The residents of this area have had to contend with a
dump here (Wex. Co. Co. landfill) for the last 20
years and should not be put upon by further
development of this kind.

3) While the digester would be a good thing if it were confined to the treatment of the waste from Renard Pigging only, what is being proposed is the importation of considerable quantities of additional waste from elsewhere. This will have traffic implications for the area, not to mention possible smells from offal, fresh waste etc...

4) This proposal changes what is currently an intensive agricultural activity into an industrial activity, generating electricity.

5) The silos and plant shown in the plans will be visible from across the river Slaney and no planting or screening has been shown / planned.

6) This is becoming an increasingly residential area and the lives of such inhabitants should be considered in

making this decision.
