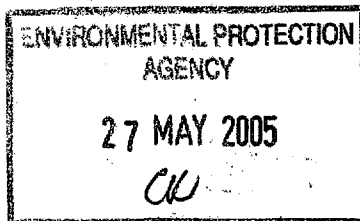


**In Opposition to the Application for an Integrated Pollution

We strenuously oppose the granting of an EPA IPPC licence (Registered No 742) to Reenard Farms Ltd at Killurin, Co. Wexford

We in Killurin have put up with the dump, for the best part of 30 years – which involved heavy traffic, sickening smells, dead seagulls on our land and all sorts of waste dumped by them in our livestock drinking troughs – bones, bread, meat and all sorts of stuff that turns into “glue”.

We oppose this licence for the following reasons

- We don't want heavy traffic on our road for years to come
- We don't want to live in the midst of foul smells
- We don't want to see the river polluted any more than it is already

As Killurin is a classified scenic area, it is very difficult to even get planning permission for a house to live in – so why should something like this be allowed on the banks of a most beautiful river – The Slaney

Our family have been boating a little upstream “at Castle” for years and sometimes swimming there

Our land borders the Reenard Pig Farm on the East side, also we have a plot of reed bed bordering Pig Farm on the west side, where it adjoins Killurin Bridge

During the last flood, the flood water from the river reached the “OUT” gate of the Recycling Depot at Killurin and if anyone looked at that they would see & understand why a licence should not be granted
