Dear Ms Leacy,

With reference to the review of the existing licence reg No. 48, (review reg No. 753) please note the following observations.

- 1. As the application for review and supporting data is not readily available to the Board, the precise details are unclear but ongoing issues of concern relate to the need for reduction in nitrogen loads to the river.
- 2.As the Board has still serious concerns in relation to the quality of water in the River Dalgan, it is doubtful if the river will be in compliance with the phosphorus regulations by the due date. The relevent EPA biological data for the river is summarised hereunder.

- 3. The need to take measures to control storm run off from the factory yard. The manangement agreed to reroute contaminated water to the WWTP following an incident in March of this year.
- 4. No environmental incidents have been reported by the company to the Board and it is unclear whither there have been no incidents or whither incidents which may have occurred have not been reported.
- 5. The Board would be opposed to a continuation of the terms of the existing licence and would recommend that the main objective of the review should be see a significant further reduction in the pollution load as discharged to the Dalgan river.
