Dear Sir/Madam

With reference to above, <u>I Totally object</u> to the granting of a waste licence to the aforementioned recycling company for reasons hereunder

- (1) Siteing an industrial waste facility in a rural area.
- (2) The increased volume of articulated vehicles on our local roads & the consequences for safety for our children who use these at present as a valuable amenity for walking & cycling.
- (3) Dust& Muck from the increased volume of lorry traffic.
- (4) Vermin, Rats, foxes, crows, seaguills, magpies, flies etc, will be attracted to & multiply in such a facility. Increasing the health risk to all humans, & domestic, wild & farm animals in the area.
- (5) Sourceing of raw material; Given that the company has told us that they will source hotel & Restaurent waste from the Dublin area. Knowing as I dothat many of these food outlets purchase meat from suppliers who in turn source this outside the strict controls of the E.U (where Foot & Mouth, T.B. Asian bird Flu etc are endemic.)
- (6) Air quality; Airbourn aspergilli will irritate our lung tissue, especially in winter when our immune system is already trying to cope with the usual colds & Flu.
- (7) Water quality; Water quality is a big issiu in Westmeath. The only Clean & safe water is from our domestic wells. TO SITE A LARGE OR ANY SIZE COMPOST FACILITY ON TOP OF A KNOWN AQUIFER IS GENOCIDE.

- 4. This plant is proposed to be constructed or an underlying aquifer which in turn feeds all the local wells in the area and also into the Kinnegad River and its spawning grounds which is a tributary of the Boyne river.
- 5. This proposed plant will also lead to an increase in pollution such as vermin, flies, odours, noise and dust.
- 6. The proposed Composting Plant ould have a serious and damaging effect on the bordering Milltownpass National Heritage Area, by their proposal to upgrade the road which would in turn lead to lowering of the natural water table of the bogland.

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

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
