Mv name is Chris De Margary and togehther with Mick Hucknall we are the new owners of the Glenmore Fishery on the upper River Finn at Glenfin, Co. Donegal.

We are in the early stages of an expansive development project for the Fishery, encompassing fishery management, river improvement and tourism growth for the area. In this project we are first and foremost coming from a conservation and environment based ethos. We are investing a substantial sum in the area and hope to encourage overseas angling tourism, generate economic growth and to create much needed employment in the Glenfin valley.

As no doubt you will be aware, the watershed of this, one of Ireland's most important salmon rivers, is a very fragile one. We therefore find it of great concern that there is a proposal for a landfill site at Meenaboll. This site is dangerously close to the Cummick River, which is the most important spawning river on the system; particularly as it is utilised by the very importar t spring runs for reproduction.

We feel that the risk to the environment and potential great dams ge that would occur in the event of leakage or spillage must in this case greatly out way any local need for a landfill site. We have spoken to Mr. Donald Casey of Donegal County Council, seeking reassurance that r o leakage would occur. Unfortunately his position is that he could not guarantee the integrity of the site

If such a development gets the green light and pollution of the river occurs, we will be forced to seek through the courts at the highest level against those directly responsible. We are fully so pportive of local objections to this proposed scheme. We are pleased that our concerns and those of the Glenfin'community are shared by the senior management of the Lough's Agency.
