

I refer to the further information in respect of the above-mentioned proposed development which was submitted by letter dated 20th of June, 2005.

The Board considers that the further information contains significant additional data relating to-

- (i) the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, and
- (ii) the likely consequences for proper planning and sustainable development in the area in which it is proposed to situate the said development of such development.

In this regard the Board now hereby requires you, in accordance with section 175(5)(b) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 to make this further information available to the public and relevant prescribed bodies and enable same make further written submissions or observations to the Board in respect of same in accordance with the following protocols-


Publish in one or more newspapers in which notice of the original approval application was first published a notice stating that further information in relation to the proposed development, which is currently the subject of an application for approval to An Bord Pleanala under section 175 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 has been submitted to An Bord Pleanála by Donegal County Council. The notice should state that the further information contains significant additional data relating to-

the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, and

the likely consequences for proper planning and sustainable development in the area in which it is proposed to situate the said development of such development.

The notice should also state that the further information will be available for inspection or purchase at a specified place and a specified times during a specified period which shall be not less than 3 weeks, and that submissions and observations in relation to the further information may be made in writing to the Board before the expiration of the indicated period.

send notice of the furnishing to the Board of the further information, and a copy of the (b) r information furnished to any prescribed authority to which notice was given pursuant to subsection (4)(b) of section 175 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 and indicate to the authority that submissions or observations in relation to the further information may be made in writing to the Board before a specified date (which shall be not less than 3 weeks beginning on the day on which notice is sent to the prescribed authority).

In respect of (a) above the notices should be published in the same newspapers in which notices of the original application was advertised and the further additional information should be made available for inspection or purchase at the same locations at which the original application documentation was available. In respect of the time limits for the making of submissions or observations in relation to the further additional information to the Board under (a) and (b) above the Board recommends that the indicated periods be not less than 4 weeks from the date of publication of the notice/sending of the notice to any prescribed authority. It would facilitate processing of the cases if the time limit for receipt of submissions or observations to the Board was stated in both cases to be not later than 5.30p.m. on a single specified day.



A copy of the relevant newspaper notice(s) and the copies of notices issued-to-prescribed bodies should be forwarded to the Board as soon as possible.
