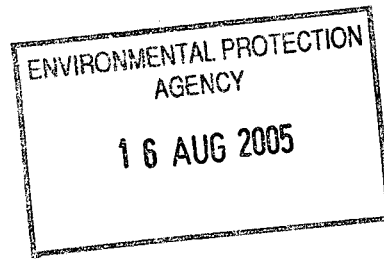

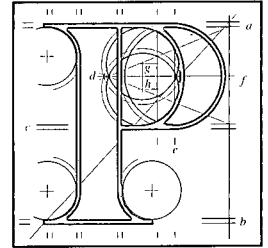

I wish to refer further to the above-mentioned case.

The Board under section 134(5) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as inserted by section 247 of the Local Government Act 2001) has decided to hold an oral hearing into this case. In this regard Mr Danny O'Connor has been instructed by the Board to hold the oral hearing. The inspector at this hearing is entitled to hear evidence in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development and the likely consequence for proper planning and sustainable development in the area in which it is proposed to situate the said development of such development and to report to the Board thereon.
