

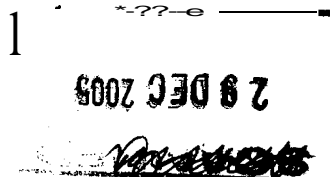

Dear Ms. Bosley,



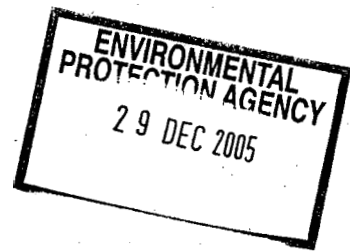
In light of this decision by the local authority, it ought to strengthen my objection **to** the development **of** such a facility *so* close to the village **of** Wilkinstown.
