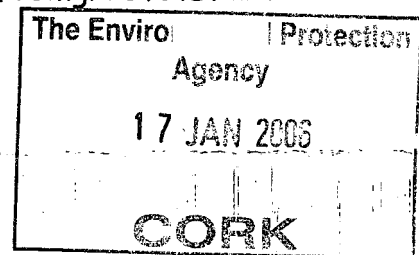
Re: Waste Licence Application from Killarney Waste Disposal.Limited.

A chara,

Refer to the above and correspondence received in connection with the application. Kerry County Council have considered the proposal to discharge trade effluent to the sewer and Killarney Waste Water Treatment Plant, and in this instance consent is refused for the following reasons:

1. It is planned that the villages of Kilcummin and Beaufort be piped into the Killarney Sewer Network and receive treatment at the Killarney Waste Water Treatment Plant in the very near future.
2. The capacity within the plant be reserved for developments within the catchment.
3. Further monitoring of Lough Leane in the future, might determine that discharge limits from the plant be set at 10mg/l B.O.D. and 10mg/l S.S.

4. Capacity be reserved for leachate from Kerry County Council transfer stations at Coolcaslagh, Kenmare, Milltown and Cahersiveen.
