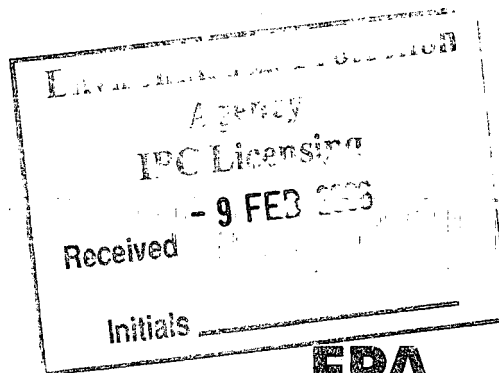

On behalf of Killurin Rowing Club members we wish to make the following comments on the inspectors report.

1.

Location. This development is located in a highly scenic area overlooking the Slaney River. This area, during the summer months has a substantial number of children enjoying sporting activities on the River Slaney and around Killurin Bridge from which fishing and other sporting activities take place. The increased traffic, transport, raw materials and digestate to and from the facility will create substantial damage to kids.

Also the proposed transport of fish products in open containers will create an unacceptable smell in the area and in the event of an accident could spread disease and pollute the river.

2.

The pipe to bring hot water from one pig factory to the other will have to pass through the bridge. This bridge is a historical bridge which, a portion of it was lifted years ago. This is totally unacceptable to our club.

3.

Scenic. This whole area around Killurin bridge is one of the most scenic in the country and buildings of 60ft high within a hundred metres of the river is totally unacceptable.



Noise. It is expected that considerable noise will be generated and as a rowing club this will have very serious effects on the team members on boats while practising and racing on the

The club spend from April to September on the river five nights a week and feel that the above is a major concern to the wellbeing, health and safety of our members.
