At a recent meeting, our rowing club (Ferrycarrig) discussed the issue of the Anaerobic Digester at the Deeps, Killurin. By a unanimous vote, it was decided to object to the granting of a licence for this development. This is to support the Killurin Rowing Club, which has suffered for years from the odours from both the Piggery and the Dump. We have an affinity with the Slaney river. Many of our boats are former fishing cots.

We were told by the experts that the reed beds would protect the river; yet it is polluted at Killurin. This is **not** the place to build an anaerobic digester. Just when the Dump is to close, and the farmers have cleaned up their act, another waste facility% planned for the banks of the river Slaney.

At the meeting, former fishermen, told us about fish smells and associated vermin and gull problems.

We object to the granting of a licence for such a facility in this location. We ask the **EPA** to put the local people and the river first.
