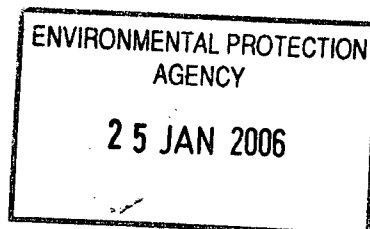

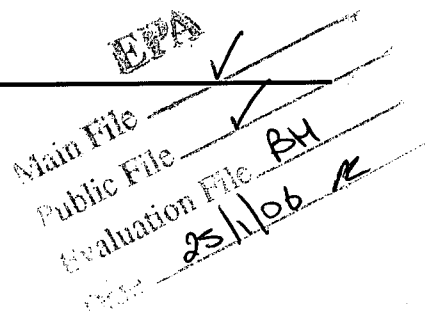
With regard to the above IPPC review, the Board has no objections from a fisheries perspective. However, the following observations are important to highlight:

- The ecological integrity of the River Tolka, an important salmonid system, must be protected at all times and should not deteriorate in any way as a result of the process under review.
- Only clean, uncontaminated surface and storm waters must be permitted to discharge to the surface water network in the area so that the salmonid status of local watercourses is protected.

I trust you will take our observations on board when addressing this review.
