RE:/ Planning Permission is sought for development at Little Connell, Newbridge, Co. Kildare. For plan and elevational changes to the previously permitted part three storey extension to the existing 3B Manufacturing building (Permit reference number 04/1713) as follows: The omission of the last double storey bay to the north elevation. Including the removal of approximately 124sqm of proposed first floor area housing plant and offices. The application consists of a variation to a previously permitted development of an activity for which a licence under part IV of the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992 is required and will be notified to the Environmental Protection Agency – AHP Manufacturing B.V. trading as Wyeth Medica Ireland – Planning Ref: 2208/05

Schedule 1: Considerations

Having regard to previous permission granted on the site, the zoning of the site for industrial use and the location of the development within an established manufacturing facility / site it is considered that the proposed development subject to the attached conditions would be accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

Schedule 2: Conditions

1) The development shall carried out and completed in accordance with drawings and documentation submitted to the planning authority on 16/9/05, except where altered or amended by conditions in this permission.

Reason: To enable the planning authority to check the proposed development when completed, by reference approved particulars.

2) The development shall not impair existing land or road drainage.

Reason: To prevent interference with existing land or road drainage in the interests of proper development.

3) Apart from the departures authorised by this permission, the development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with the terms and conditions of Previous Permission 04/1713, and any agreements entered into thereunder.

Reason: In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

4) The applicant shall obtain a Fire Safety Certificate and lodge a Commencement Notice in accordance with the requirements of the Building Control Act 1990 before development commences.

Reason: In the interest of fire safety.
