Dear Sir / Madam

As a native of Belmullet and a resident of North West Mayo I wish to express my concerns about the application by Shell E&P Ireland Ltd for a waste licence which will enable them to discharge toxic waste into Broad Haven Bay.

These waters are home to many protected marine mammals (including all five Annex 2 species) and the granting of this licence would be in breach of the E.U. Habitat and Water Quality directives.

In addition the discharging of toxins including heavy metals into a bay area will eventually enter the food chain and cause serious health problems in the future.

I trust that those points will be taken into consideration when reviewing Shell E&P waste licence application. Thank you.
