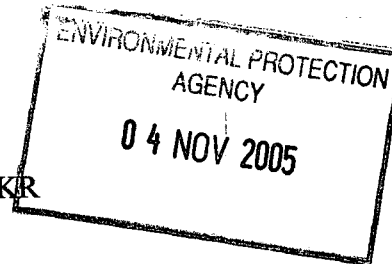

Dear Sir/Madam,

Myself, and my wife and three children moved to Crossabeg in 2000. We built a house in Killowen, Crossabeg, and moved there because of its close access to town, and also because of its beautiful natural surrounding and access to the river.

We are upset with the proposed development of an Anaerobic Digester, as there is no doubt it would cause an odour, and therefore would mean that our access and water sports would be curtailed on the River Slaney.

There is also the issue of the transport of vehicles to the Anaerobic Digester which would also be smelly and would certainly cause distress to us and our neighbours.

We also support in full the Crossabeg/Killurin Community Action Group when they make the point that this is not located in a remote area, but in a highly populated area with an increased number of houses being built, and also a proposal to build more.

It is a tourist area. It is an area of outstanding beauty with a high sporting amenity. It is served by a busy road, which is not capable of carrying current traffic loads.
