
We refer to your letter of 16 March 2004 in relation to the above-mentioned licence application and apologise for the delay in responding. Outlined below are the nature conservation comments/recommendations of the Heritage and Planning Division of the Department of Environment, Heritage and Local Government.

We would like to point out that some of the townlands for land-spreading listed on page 30 of the IPC licence application form fall partially within proposed or designated sites for nature conservation. We request that the EPA ensure that a thorough check is carried out to ensure that none of the land-spread sites fall within the nature conservation sites.
