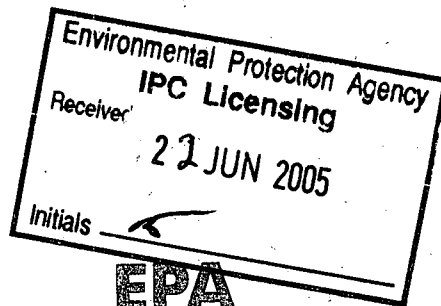

I am concerned about the fact that Lagan Cement is looking for planning permission and an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control licence (Ref No 752) to burn Meat and bone Meal in its cement factory at Kellaskillen, Kinneaghd.

I live in this area and wish to oppose to this proposal. I feel that we cannot be guaranteed that there are no side-effects to the burning of M.B.M. There has not been enough research into the possible side-effects. I think that there will be a potential risk to the air-quality in the area. There is also the possible risks to the water supply of the area. There is also the de-valuation of property in the area. I would have concerns that if this licence is granted, Lagan would burn other waste materials and we would have an incinerator in the area.
