We note the close proximity of the proposed outfall location to the boundary of the

In the event of a failure in the proposed treatment process leading to unscheduled discharge volumes and/or concern that Broadhaven Bay cSAC may be significantly impacted.

Accordingly, we would suggest that the Environmental Protection Agency ensure the effluent outfall location is of sufficient distance from the Broadhaven Bay cSAC boundary to ensure that cumulative and/or unscheduled discharges will not adversely impinge its integrity.
