I am to advise you that the Agency has received an application from Pfizer Overseas Pharmaceuticals and C.P. Pharmaceuticals International C.V. (a limited partnership represented by and acting through Pfizer Manufacturing LLC and Pfizer Production LLC) trading as Pfizer Ireland Pharmaceuticals, Little Island, Cork, for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) licence.

The applicant proposes as part of his application to provide for the discharge of process effluent to the sanitary authority's sewer. Process effluent includes trade effluent and other matter (other than domestic sewage or storm water). Details of the proposed emissions to the sanitary authority's sewer are contained in the application form.
