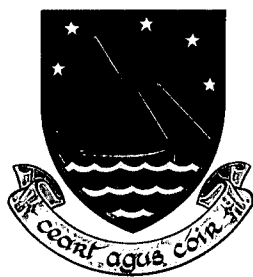

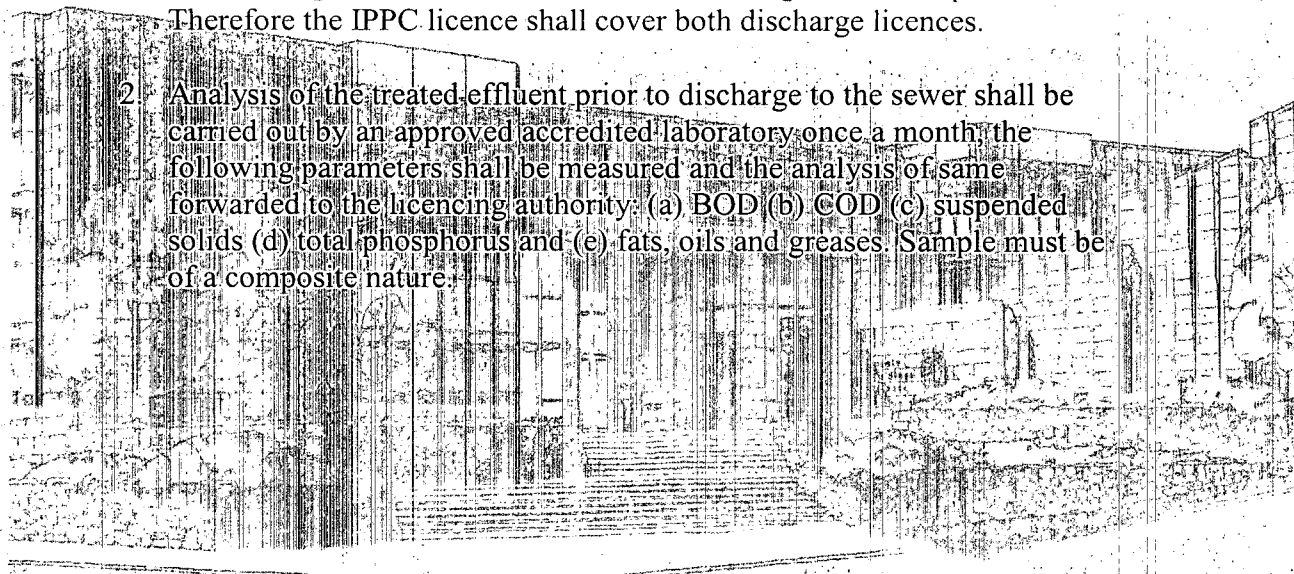
I refer to your letter dated the 12th of October 2006 concerning the application for an IPPC licence by Sean Duffy (Exports) Ltd., Gort, Co. Galway. Please find enclosed the completed 'Sanitary Authority Response' form.

Please be advised that there are currently two discharge licences issued by Galway County Council to Mr Sean Duffy.

1. S 30/78 Sean Duffy and Co Ltd., Gort, Co. Galway;
2. S 60/91 Sean Duffy Export Ltd., Gort Co. Galway. A copy of this licence and a map showing the discharge point was given to Ms. Marian Doyle during her visit to County Hall last month; please refer to same for further details.

Additional consent conditions requested by Galway County Council are as follows:

1. All discharges from this site should be via a single emission point. Therefore the IPPC licence shall cover both discharge licences.
2. Analysis of the treated effluent prior to discharge to the sewer shall be carried out by an approved accredited laboratory once a month; the following parameters shall be measured and the analysis of same forwarded to the licencing authority: (a) BOD (b) COD (c) suspended solids (d) total phosphorus and (e) fats, oils and greases. Sample must be of a composite nature.



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

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3. A continuous flow meter shall be installed on the treatment plant to allow for the measuring and recording of the daily volume of treated effluent discharged to the sewer.
4. The licensee must comply with Galway County Councils water pricing policy.
5. If analysis show that the quality of the treated effluent exceeds the specification as outlined in *Schedule B Emission Limits to Sewer*; the Local Authority shall have the facility to charge a penal rate for every Kg of excess in all of the main parameters. The rate of charge is to be decided at a later date.
