I refer to the application for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) licence by the Queally Group, The Maudlins Industrial Estate, Naas, Co.Kildare Reg No: P0812-01. As a Business owner/operator in Maudlins Industrial Estate, I would like at this time to object to such a licence being approved. The grounds for my objection are as follows:

- Odour Nuisance: For a period that spans at least ten years, the odour being emitted from the Oueally Group building is extremely unpleasant. This stench exists at all times of the day and night and makes it impossible for anyone at my premises to open windows or doors.
- Atmospheric Pollution: I would like confirmation that any emissions from the Queally Group building are not contributing to the pollution of the atmosphere in which I inhabit.
- Environmental Nuisance
- Health & Safety: I have employed and currently employ individuals who are complaining of headaches, nausea etc. I would like confirmation that is not being caused by any omissions by the Queally Group operation.
- Noise Pollution: at present there exists an unwanted/harmful out door sound created by operating machinery being emitted by the Queally Group site. This makes it very difficult for my staff to concentrate during the working day and uncomfortable for them to work outside when the needs arises.
- Contamination

There are sludge tanks, oil tanks and a deep pit handling fats and waste 1 meter away from my back door. There is also a cooking procedure one meter along one side of my from my back door. There is also a cooking building, so you can imagine what that smells like for the last 10 years!

I need assurance from your offices that the emissions from these premises are fully in compliance with planning health & safety and other regulatory authorities and are not a health hazard to my staff.

I have over the past ten years made my objections well known with both the Queally Group, Kildare County Council, Environmental Health Officer / Health Service Executive Naas and Naas Town Council who until recently controlled the issuing of licences in the area.

I trust that I will receive correspondence from you before any decision is reached in this matter.
