

Dear Sir/Madam,

I refer to enclosed item outlining the application for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control Licence (IPPC) under Class 7.4.1. See above reference.

My concern is that firstly the notice in the Irish Times is headed under **France** which is misleading and totally incorrect, I contacted the Irish Times drawing their attention to the error, they replied they were instructed to place this advertisement exactly as it was presented to them. Why would Kepak wish to mislead the public in this way?

Secondly the idea of a beef slaughterhouse plant dealing with a **carcass production capacity greater than 50 tonnes per day** is both unbelievable horrific and appalling. How much greater than 50 tonnes per day can we expect?

Kilbeggan has expanded within the last six months with over 600 new houses in and around the town. Will this plant enhance the lives of the locals, I think not. The infrastructure around the town has not the capacity to withstand yet another huge development and especially one of this type where emissions and overflow are part of the overall operation of a beef slaughterhouse.

I wish to obtain a copy of the formal application at your earliest convenience so as to formulate my opposition to such a development, and would appreciate your co-operation in this request. Thanking you in anticipation.
