
Dear Ms O'Keefe,

I refer to yours of 19th April re a letter of objection you received from the applicant to your proposed granting of an IPPC licence.

Having looked at the items covered in the letter, it would appear that they relate more to conditions imposed by yourselves in the EPA rather than by the Drainage Division of DCC. In general they appear to object to the timeframes you have imposed on them to carry out certain works, (eg items 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6 of their letter). Their cover letter confirms their concerns when they identify "time and cost" as their main issue in the context of their budgets for 2007 having already been identified and committed.

I would suggest that any future queries you have concerning drainage pollution should be addressed directly to the Senior Engineer, Drainage Division at the address below. This will ensure your communication reaches the responsible person without delay and hence enables us to respond quickly to any issue you raise. It would also be helpful to assist our prompt response if you could indicate on all future communications the name and direct telephone number of the EPA inspector dealing with the issue.
