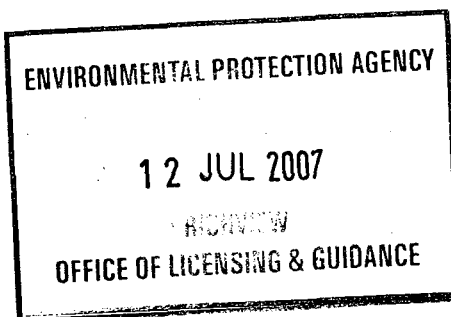

**Re: Fingal County Council Response to Swords Laboratory Objections.**

Dear Madam,

Fingal County Council has reviewed the Objections made by Swords Laboratory regarding the Proposed Determination issued by the EPA on 20<sup>th</sup> April 2007. Several of the objections relate to conditions drafted by the EPA concerning Air / Waste / and general management of the IPPC Licence.

Consent conditions relating to the trade effluent discharge to sewer which were objected to were:

**C.3.2** It has been requested that temperature be monitored daily rather than continuously.

Fingal County Council agrees to Swords Laboratory's request to monitor temperature daily rather than continuously.

It has been requested that effluent Toxicity testing (aquatic and activated sludge) be reduced from quarterly testing to annual testing.

Fingal County Council requests that effluent Toxicity testing be carried out quarterly in order to document protection of the performance of the Swords Wastewater Treatment Plant and the local receiving waters.
