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Gary,

As discussed today I am a consultant engineer to An Taisce the National Trust for Ireland and have advised them on the compliance of the Corrib Gas Project with international codes of practice. The Regulator in Ireland for pipeline consents is the Minister for Natural Resources and in his approvals for the upstream pipelines for this project there is no provision for the developer to comply with a code of practice. Are there any circumstances where the Department of Trade and Industry in the UK would issue a pipeline consent for a pipeline without a requirement for the infrastructure to comply with a code of practice?
