

The current cost of treating the effluent was €1.70/m3 compares with €1.22/m3 that was set in 1993, which you are currently paying. This cost is based on an effluent quality of 300mg/L BOD. If the strength of the effluent were to increase to 600mg/L the unit cost would increase to €3.40/m3. The 300mg/L is the lower limit, even if the quality was to go below this we would have a hydraulic load to cater for.
