Dear Sir/ Madame

We wish to lodge an **Objection** and request and **Oral Hearing** to the above proposed Waste Licence for the proposed incinerator in Poolbeg Peninsula.

We are making this objections on the grounds that:

- A) An Incinerator is bad for the environment and to the health and safety of those who live near it, as we know an incinerator has to be kept burning once it has begun, they are known to break down often sending thick smoke, fumes and harmful substances into the air and therefore into the lungs and bodies of everybody around it.
- B) An Incinerator will discourage people to recycle as we can see all our recycling sent to the incinerator to keep it operational, again bad for the environment.
- C) Traffic congestion in the area around the Poolbeg Peninsula is already congested most of the day, bringing more traffic, trucks and rubbish trucks into the area is going to make it much worse. People can just about get in and out of their homes with peak time traffic to and from the East Link Bridge and we do not want that type of traffic all day. It will end up the same as the West Link.
